History: Calvary Home directed by Suresh and his wife, Madhavi, has been open since 1993. Suresh was well prepared for this job after growing up in Karen's Cottage, another home of Children of Promise International. Through his many experiences he has learned what poor children need and long for—a family. Suresh has a degree in engineering. He pursued this field but never

had peace in his life. Then he and his wife, accepted the call to direct a home, to spend their lives for the children, and moved into the rented building with their son and their thirty new children. The Lord provided the funds to purchase one acre of land to construct a new home for the children. The new home is wonderful

and has lots of space to play. In 2006 they were also able to buy bunk-beds for the children, a dream come true for Suresh and Madhavi.

Program: They take the children into the home and provide for them, both physically and spiritually. All the children are being brought up in the Christian way of life. Their goals are that the children will come to know Jesus



and will become great warriors in the battle of winning souls for God's kingdom. The program is based on Bible teaching. The children stay in the home from two to ten years, depending upon the child's family and background. Sometimes the parents come to a place where they can provide for their children and take them back. The children that are completely orphaned generally stay until they are able to provide for themselves. Since the home opened, they have provided loving care for 130 children. Suresh and his wife work to provide a family atmosphere. They enjoy doing many things together as a family. The home raises different kinds of birds, and owns three dogs. The children also enjoy playing games and playing on the playground equipment. They garden as a family too. Sundays after church and lunch, the whole family rests together

while Suresh tells stories. The children all go to public school with the three wheeler that was purchased for the home. They graduate after completing a three-year college course, with help through Children of Promise's further education program. Meals at the home include rice with vegetable curry, curd, milk, buttermilk, and fruit. Eggs and meat are on the menu once a week. The Lord provided two water buffalos, so the children get milk each day, and a well, so they are able to have fresh vegetables from their garden.
